Delve into the region's fascinating geology and rich human history—from the Indigenous peoples who first lived here to the legendary expeditions of Samuel Hearne and Franklin (1819–1822) and the transformative diamond rush of the 1990s.

Wildlife roams over this rugged terrain – some species reside here throughout the year, while others follow their traditional migration routes. The barrens also serve as an important breeding ground for various species of birds, they stay for a few short months to have and rear their young. Keep your eyes peeled for migrating caribou, grizzlies, wolves, and majestic raptors, as well as waterfowl like the rare Yellow-billed Loon and the hardy small birds, such as the Harris Sparrow.
